**1. Call Meeting to Order**

Meeting called to order by Shaun Wood at 4:45 PM on 2/22/2023.

**2. Approve Agenda**

- a. Motion to approve 2/22/2023 agenda by Dave Poffinbarger, seconded by Adam Grassl. Motion approved unanimously.

**3. Approve Minutes from October 27, 2022**

- a. Motion to approve 10/27/23 minutes by Peter Strand, seconded Dave Poffinbarger. Motion approved unanimously.

**4. Election of Officers**

- a. **Chair Elect** – No nominations offered. Nomination and vote moved to end of meeting.
- b. **LIO at large** – Adam Grassl nominated himself. Motion to approve by Eric Damkot. Seconded by Jeff Hartman. Passed unanimously.

**5. State Agency - LTSB update, Zach Robinson**

- a. Ward Changes accepted in January. Thank you.
- b. Asked membership if need for WISE-LR training was needed. Consensus was not right now.
- c. Thanked people for their feedback on the WISE-LR & Redistricting survey.

**6. State Agency – SAGIC Update, Zach Robinson**

- a. Working on future priorities
- b. DOT looking at options for single-source imagery and LiDAR cloud storage.
- c. ESRI Master Purchasing Agreement expires 3/31/23. If not renewed, an extension may be granted.
- d. SAGIC looking at what is required to build a statewide building layer.

**7. WLIA Legislative Update, Nik Anderson**

- a. Currently working on determining authoritative school district boundaries. Working with WRPLA and DPI.
- b. Determination that parcels split by school districts could be placed with the majority school district per RPL.
- c. Daniels Law: WLIA reached out to Attorney General Josh Kaul
  - i. Haven't heard much feedback. Still in early stages as to impacts.
  - ii. Clarification by Fred lausly that Daniel's law is information shielding, not redaction.

- d. Talk of changes in fees for recorded document filings is in early stages.

## **8. Department of Administration (DOA) Program Update**

### **a. Jim Giglierano, GIO**

- i. Statewide LiDAR is complete.
- ii. USGS looking at LiDAR derived hydrography project.
- iii. DNR also looking into updating hydro for the state using LiDAR.
- iv. DOA looking at statewide Building footprint inventory where building outlines are merged with assessment data.
- v. Great Lakes Water and Land Presentation is available.
- vi. Eric Damkot raised the issue of the practicality/feasibility of assembling assessment data statewide. lausly discussed the role of DOR and if DOR should be compiling all tax information for statewide parcels rather than 72 counties each expending effort to compile that data for inclusion in statewide parcels.

### **b. Peter Herreid, Grant Administrator**

- i. Call for v.9 of statewide parcels going on currently.
- ii. 2023 Strategic Initiative grants were awarded at the \$70k level.
- iii. Document recording figures are down about 50% from two years ago.
- iv. If the number of documents recorded does not pick up in the coming months, the Strategic Initiative Grant eligibility level for 2024 may be around \$10-20k.

## **9. Website Domain and Private Registration**

- a. Donations were taken to pay for annual domain fees. \$120 were raised from various volunteers. Thank you LIOs!

- a. Call for Chair-Elect nominations made by Shaun Wood. Rob Sommers motioned to nominate himself for LION Chair-Elect to succeed Brett Budrow. Jeremiah Erickson seconded. Opened for discussion. No other candidates stepped forward. Motion by Dave Poffinbarger to elect Rob Sommers as new LION Chair-Elect, seconded by Jeremiah Erickson. Vote passed unanimously.
