8. Legislative Technology Services Bureau (LTSB) – Presented by Ryan Squires Thank you everyone for submitting your wards. BVP Notifications – Check the box if boundaries are correct. DPI – 71 of the 72 Counties submitted school districts. Parcel Boundaries are being submitted now.

- 9. SCO Update Howard Veregin and Richard Kleinmann WSRS 2022 was created about 1 ½ years ago. It introduces 2 datums which shift your coordinates a significant amount. We have reached the final stage of negotiations with NSPS. We have reached an agreement that they will officially recognize WISCRS, WTM(Similar). There will be more details during our 90 minute session on Friday morning 10:00-11:30 am. This will have an impact on your data! Richard stated he is dealing with NGS coordinate systems and moving towards focus groups: 1) Technical 2) Legislative 3) Education and Outreach and 4) software and hardware. WLIA Annual Conference – LION meeting 2/19/2020

Dear LIO's

I apologize for not being there in person. I'm working on final touches for the Opening/Social Event tonight. I hope you all are attending, it will be a fun event! This will be a brief update. Much of what occurred at today's WLIC meeting will be discussed by the others presenting here.

The council last met October 23rd in Ashland, the day before WLIA's Fall Regional conference. An update was provided at the WLIA fall regional LION meeting there. Proposed bylaw amendments were discussed at that meeting and some changes were made. There was an update on the LiDAR Grants & State Elevation Planning Process. Much of the discussion at that meeting centered on the WLIA's Address and Street Centerline Standards. Many of the questions about the standards, and specific technical questions that were expressed early and mid-last year have been largely addressed.

The WLIC has not officially endorsed the standards, but is committed to continued support of WLIA's efforts. The council is waiting to see what happens with NG9-1-1 activities, along with DMA's gap analysis.

LION had endorsed the WLIA Address and Road Centerline Data Standards at the February 2019 WLIA Annual meeting, however if any LIO has questions or comments, please feel free to bring them to me (Kelly) or Zach at any time. WLIA wants to help every county understand these standards.
